

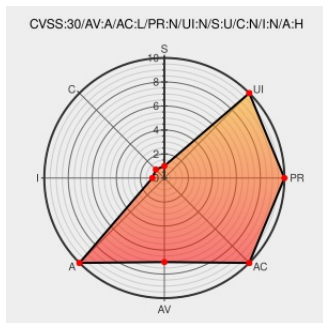

Certain versions of [Eos](#) from [Arista](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Arista EOS through 4.21.0F allows a crash because 802.1x authentication is mishandled.
