Certain versions of [Libgig](#) from [Linuxsampler](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue was discovered in libgig 4.1.0. There is an out-of-bounds write in the function DLS::Info::UpdateChunks in DLS.cpp.

CVE-2018-14457 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
