Certain versions of [lsweb](#) from [lsweb](#) contain the following vulnerability:

CMS ISWEB 3.5.3 is vulnerable to multiple SQL injection flaws. An attacker can inject malicious queries into the application and obtain sensitive information.

CVE-2018-14956 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
