

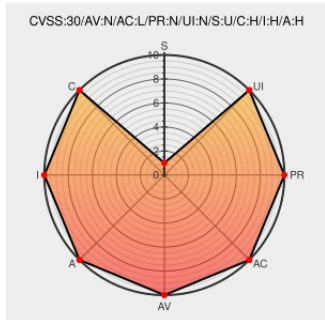

Certain versions of [Zipabox](#) from [Zipato](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Weak hashing algorithm in Zipato Zipabox Smart Home Controller BOARD REV - 1 with System Version -118 allows unauthenticated attacker extract clear text passwords and get root access on the device.
