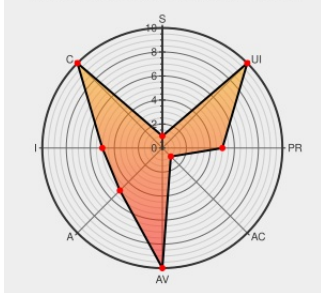

Inova Partner 5.0.5-RELEASE, Build 0510-0906 and earlier allows authenticated users authorization bypass and data manipulation in certain functions.
