

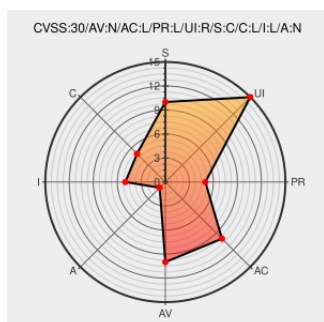

Certain versions of [Webaccess](#) from [Advantech](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Advantech WebAccess 8.3.1 and 8.3.2 are vulnerable to cross-site scripting in the Bwmainleft.asp page. An attacker could leverage this vulnerability to disclose credentials amongst other things.

CVE-2018-15707 has been assigned by vulnreport@tenable.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
