

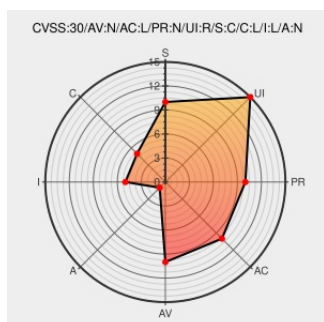

Certain versions of [Spam-byebye](#) from [Ohtanz](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Cross-site scripting vulnerability in WordPress plugin spam-byebye 2.2.1 and earlier allows remote attackers to inject arbitrary web script or HTML via unspecified vectors.

CVE-2018-16206 has been assigned by [vultures@jpcert.or.jp](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
