

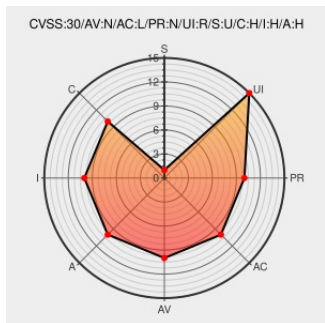

Certain versions of [Fuel Cms](#) from [Thedaylightstudio](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Cross-site request forgery (CSRF) vulnerability in my_profile/edit? inline= in FUEL CMS 1.4 allows remote attackers to change the administrator's password.

CVE-2018-16416 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
