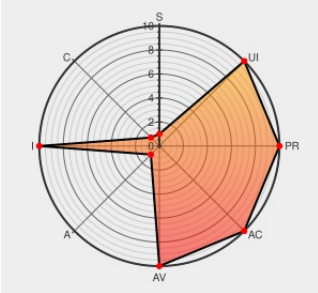

Certain versions of [Seacms](#) from [Seamcms](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue was discovered in SeaCMS through 6.61.

adm1n/admin_database.php allows remote attackers to delete arbitrary files via directory traversal sequences in the bakfiles parameter. This can allow the product to be reinstalled by deleting install_lock.txt.

CVE-2018-16446 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
