COYO 9.0.8, 10.0.11 and 12.0.4 has cross-site scripting (XSS) via URLs used by "iFrame" widgets.

CVE-2018-16519 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
