

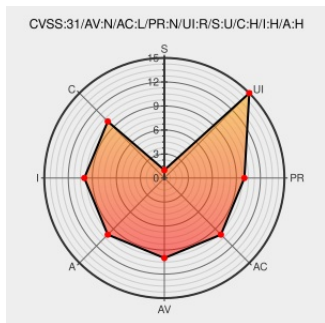

Certain versions of [Openemr](#) from [Open-emr](#) contain the following vulnerability:

OpenEMR 5.0.1.3 allows Cross-Site Request Forgery (CSRF) via library/ajax and interface/super, as demonstrated by use of interface/super/manage_site_files.php to upload a .php file.

CVE-2018-16795 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
