

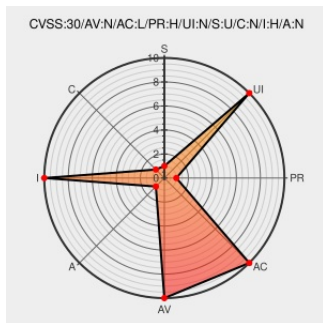

Certain versions of [Monstra](#) from [Monstra](#) contain the following vulnerability:

admin/index.php in Monstra CMS 3.0.4 allows arbitrary file deletion via id=filesmanager&path=uploads/.....//. ....//.&delete\_file= requests.

CVE-2018-16819 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
