

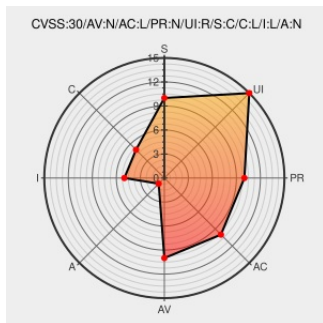

Certain versions of [Cqu Lankers](#) from [Cqu Lankers Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

CQU-LANKERS through 2017-11-02 has XSS via the public/api.php callback parameter in an uploadpic action.

CVE-2018-17049 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
