

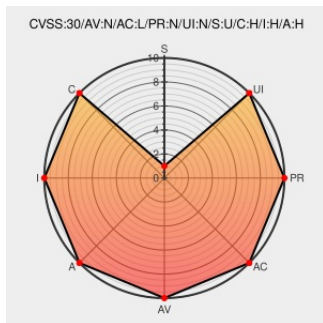

Certain versions of [Next](#) from [Prezi](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Prezi Next 1.3.101.11 has a documented purpose of creating HTML5 presentations but has SE_DEBUG_PRIVILEGE on Windows, which might allow attackers to bypass intended access restrictions.

CVE-2018-17137 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
