

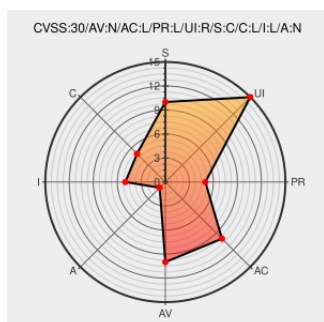

Certain versions of [Jibu Pro](#) from [Nickelpro](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The Jibu Pro plugin through 1.7 for WordPress is prone to Stored XSS via the wp-content/plugins/jibu-pro/quiz_action.php name (aka Quiz Name) field.

CVE-2018-17138 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
