

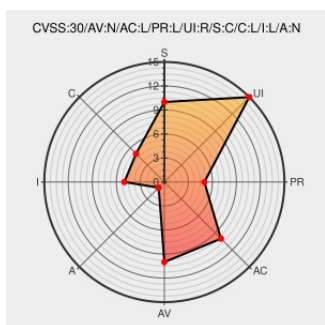

Certain versions of [Quizlord](#) from [Vms-studio](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The Quizlord plugin through 2.0 for WordPress is prone to Stored XSS via the title parameter in a ql_insert action to wp-admin/admin.php.

CVE-2018-17140 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
