

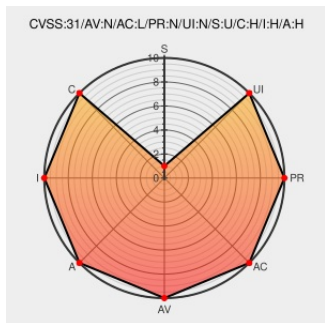

Certain versions of [Jck Editor](#) from [Arkextensions](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The JCK Editor component 6.4.4 for Joomla! allows SQL Injection via the jtreelink/dialogs/links.php parent parameter.

CVE-2018-17254 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
