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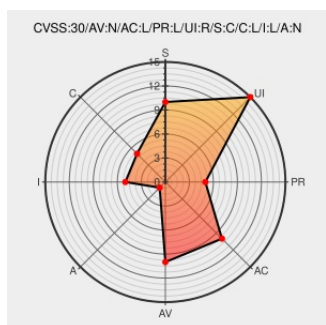

Stored XSS exists in views/fields/wysiwyg.js in EspoCRM 5.3.6 via a `/#Email/view saved draft message`.
