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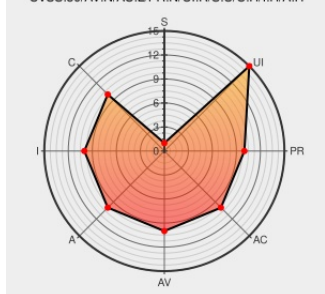

An issue was discovered in MCMS 4.6.5. There is a CSRF vulnerability that can add an administrator account via `ms/basic/manager/save.do`.
