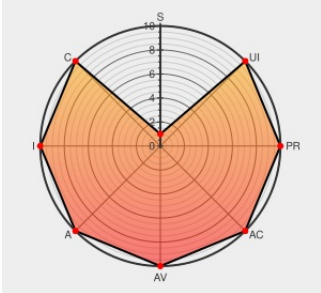

Certain versions of [Navigate Cms](#) from [Naviwebs](#) contain the following vulnerability:

SQL Injection in login.php in Naviwebs Navigate CMS 2.8 allows remote attackers to bypass authentication via the navigate-user cookie.

CVE-2018-17552 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
