

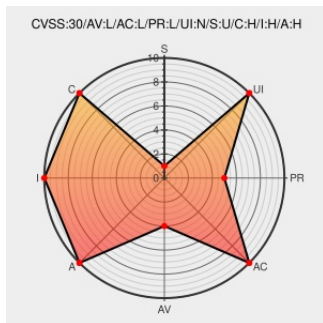

Certain versions of [End Point Security](#) from [Seqrite](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Seqrite End Point Security v7.4 has "Everyone: (F)" permission for %PROGRAMFILES%\Seqrite\Seqrite, which allows local users to gain privileges by replacing an executable file with a Trojan horse.

CVE-2018-17775 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
