

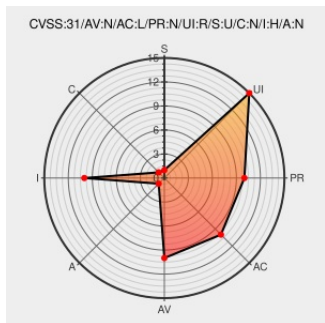

Prospecta Master Data Online (MDO) allows CSRF.
