Certain versions of [Mushroom Content Management System](#) from [Mushroom Content Management System Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue was discovered in MRCMS (aka mushroom) through 3.1.2. The WebParam.java file directly accepts the FIELD_T parameter in a request and uses it as a hash of SQL statements without filtering, resulting in a SQL injection vulnerability in getChannel() in the

ChannelService.java file.

CVE-2018-17796 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
