

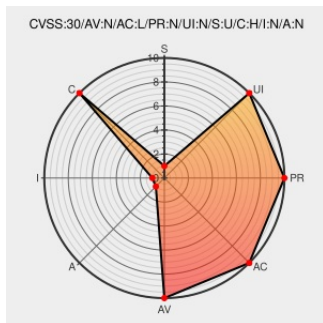

Certain versions of [Jtbc Php](#) from [Jtbc](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue was discovered in JTBC(PHP) 3.0.1.6. Arbitrary file read operations are possible via a `/console/#/console/file/manage.php?type=list&path=c:/` substring.

CVE-2018-17838 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
