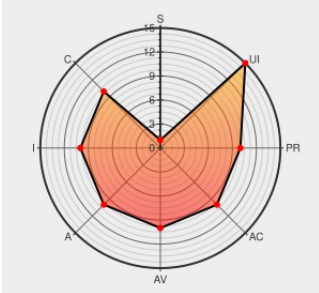

Certain versions of [Wuzhi Cms](#) from [Wuzhicms](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue was discovered in WUZHI CMS 4.1.0. There is a CSRF vulnerability that can change the super administrator's password via `index.php?m=core&f=panel&v=edit_info`.

CVE-2018-18711 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](mailto:cve@mitre.org) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
