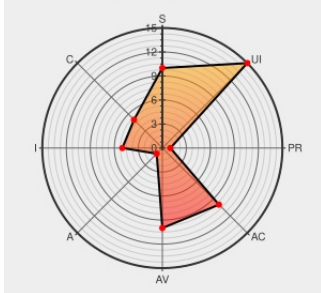

Certain versions of [Semcms](#) from [Sem-cms](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An XSS issue was discovered in SEMCMS 3.4 via the `admin/SEMCMS_Categories.php?pid=1&lgid=1 category_key` parameter.

CVE-2018-18738 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
