

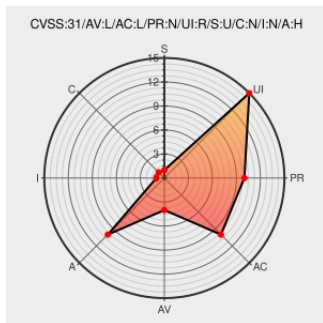

Certain versions of [Data Tools](#) from [Data Tools Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

data-tools through 2017-07-26 has an Integer Overflow leading to an incorrect end value for the write_wchars function.

CVE-2018-18749 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
