

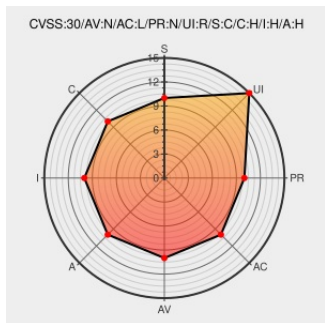

Certain versions of [Enterprise Va Max](#) from [Loadbalancer](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Loadbalancer.org Enterprise VA MAX before 8.3.3 has XSS because Apache HTTP Server logs are displayed.

CVE-2018-18864 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
