

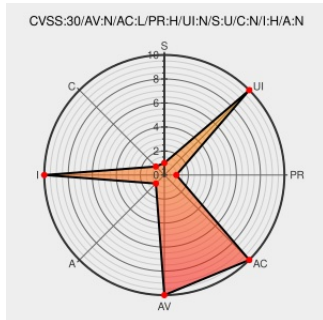

Certain versions of [Xiaocms](#) from [Xiaocms](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue was discovered in XiaoCms 20141229.

admin/controller/database.php allows arbitrary directory deletion via admin/index.php?c=database&a=import&paths[]=../ directory traversal.

CVE-2018-19197 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
