

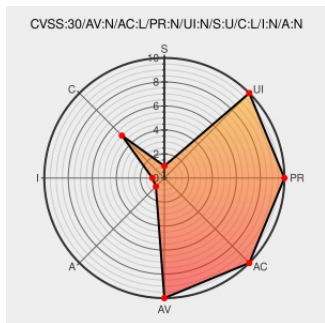

Certain versions of [Laobancms](#) from [Laobancms](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue was discovered in LAOBANCMS 2.0. It allows remote attackers to list .txt files via a direct request for the /data/0/admin.txt URI.

CVE-2018-19226 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
