

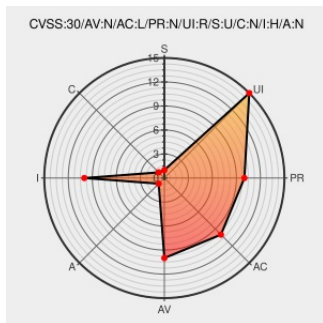

Certain versions of [Webgalamb](#) from [Ens](#) contain the following vulnerability:

wg7.php in Webgalamb 7.0 lacks security measures to prevent CSRF attacks, as demonstrated by wg7.php?options=1 to change the administrator password.

CVE-2018-19511 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
