Certain versions of [Tp5cms](#) from [Tp5cms Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An issue was discovered in tp5cms through 2017-05-25. `admin.php/upload/picture.html` allows remote attackers to execute arbitrary PHP code by uploading a .php file with the image/jpeg content type.

CVE-2018-19692 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
