

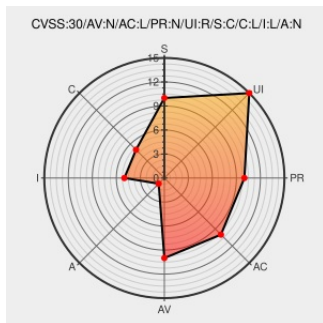

Dolibarr ERP/CRM through 8.0.3 has /exports/export.php? datatoexport= XSS.
