

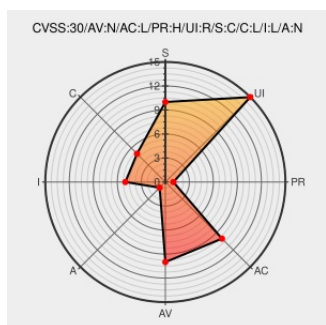

DomainMOD through 4.11.01 has XSS via the assets/add/registrar-accounts.php UserName, Reseller ID, or notes field.

CVE-2018-19913 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
