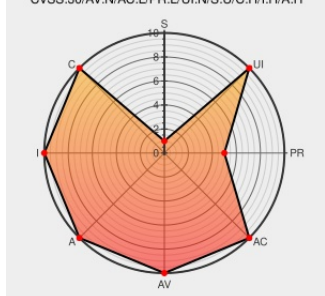

Certain versions of [Dolibarr](#) from [Dolibarr](#) contain the following vulnerability:

SQL injection vulnerability in user/card.php in Dolibarr version 8.0.2 allows remote authenticated users to execute arbitrary SQL commands via the employee parameter.

CVE-2018-19998 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
