Certain versions of [Cbw700n](#) from [Teknotel](#) contain the following vulnerability:

TEKNOTELE CBW700N 81.447.392110.729.024 devices allow remote attackers to discover credentials via iso.3.6.1.4.1.4491.2.4.1.1.6.1.1.0 and iso.3.6.1.4.1.4491.2.4.1.1.6.1.2.0 SNMP requests.

CVE-2018-20391 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
