

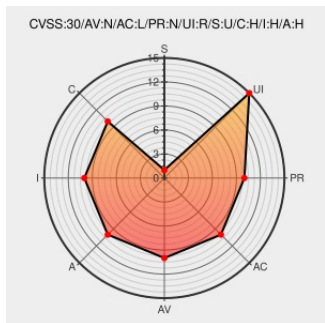

Certain versions of [Nedi](#) from [Nedi](#) contain the following vulnerability:

A cross site request forgery (CSRF) vulnerability in NeDi before 1.7Cp3 allows remote attackers to escalate privileges via User-Management.php.

CVE-2018-20728 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
