

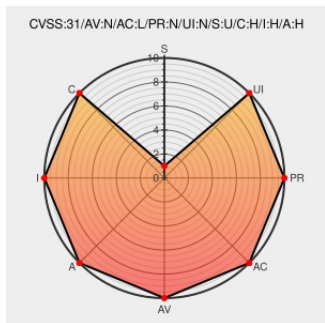

Certain versions of [Centreon](#) from [Centreon](#) contain the following vulnerability:

licenseUpload.php in Centreon Web before 2.8.27 allows attackers to upload arbitrary files via a POST request.

CVE-2018-21024 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
