

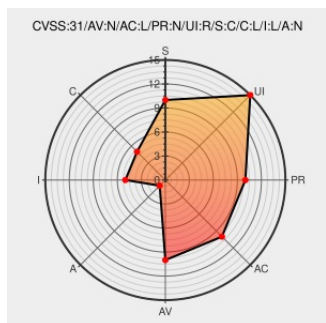

Certain versions of [Sexstatic](#) from [Sexstatic Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

XSS in sexstatic <=0.6.2 causes HTML injection in directory name(s) leads to Stored XSS when malicious file is embed with <iframe> element used in directory name.

CVE-2018-3755 has been assigned by [h1](#) support@hackerone.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
