

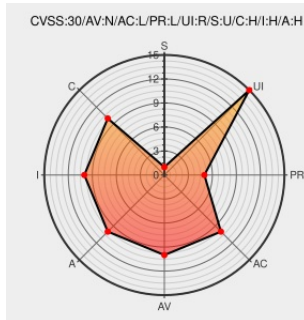

Certain versions of [Phantompdf](#) from [Foxitsoftware](#) contain the following vulnerability:

An exploitable use-after-free vulnerability exists in the JavaScript engine of Foxit Software's Foxit PDF Reader, version 9.2.0.9297. A specially crafted PDF document can trigger a previously freed object in memory to be reused, resulting in arbitrary code execution. An attacker needs to trick the user to open the malicious file to trigger this

vulnerability. If the browser plugin extension is enabled, visiting a malicious site can also trigger the vulnerability.

CVE-2018-3992 has been assigned by [cisco](#) talos-cna@cisco.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
