The Testimonial Slider plugin through 1.2.4 for WordPress has SQL Injection via settings\sliders.php (current\_slider\_id parameter).

CVE-2018-5372 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
