

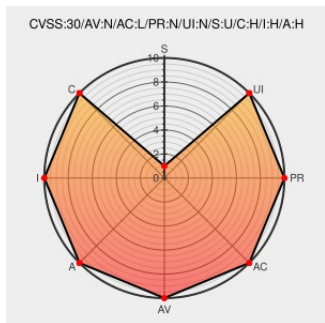

Certain versions of [Zechat](#) from [Zechat Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

SQL Injection exists in Facebook Style Php Ajax Chat Zechat 1.5 via the login.php User field.

CVE-2018-5978 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
