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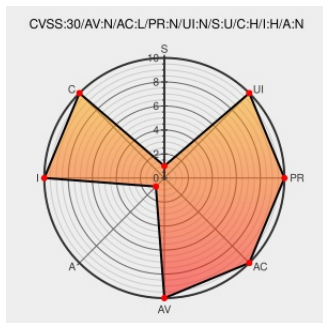

Certain versions of [Tinder](#) from [Tinder](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Unencrypted transmission of images in Tinder iOS app and Tinder Android app allows an attacker to extract private sensitive information by sniffing network traffic.

CVE-2018-6017 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
