

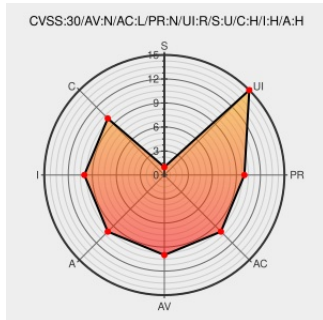

Certain versions of [Chrome](#) from [Google](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Type confusion in JavaScript in Google Chrome prior to 67.0.3396.87 allowed a remote attacker to perform an out of bounds memory write via a crafted HTML page.

CVE-2018-6149 has been assigned by [Google](#) security@google.com to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
