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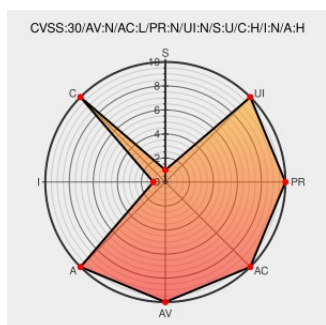

Certain versions of [Claymore Dual Miner](#) from [Claymore Dual Miner Project](#) contain the following vulnerability:

The remote management interface in Claymore Dual Miner 10.5 and earlier is vulnerable to an unauthenticated format string vulnerability, allowing remote attackers to read memory or cause a denial of service.

CVE-2018-6317 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **CRITICAL** severity.
