

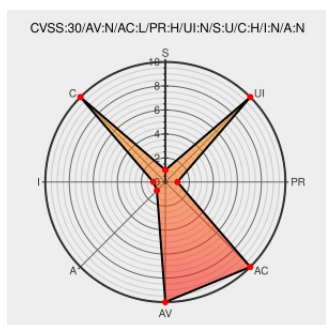

Certain versions of [Piwigo](#) from [Piwigo](#) contain the following vulnerability:

Piwigo before 2.9.3 has SQL injection in admin/tags.php in the administration panel, via the tags array parameter in an admin.php? page=tags request. The attacker must be an administrator.

CVE-2018-6883 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
