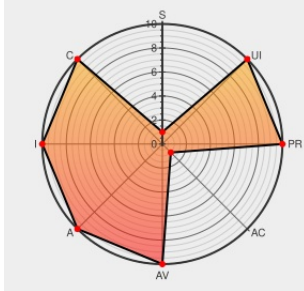

Certain versions of [Final Fantasy XIV](#) from [Square-enix](#) contain the following vulnerability:

ffxivlauncher.exe in Square Enix Final Fantasy XIV 4.21 and 4.25 on Windows is affected by Improper Enforcement of Message Integrity During Transmission in a Communication Channel, allowing a man-in-the-middle attacker to steal user credentials because a session retrieves global.js via http before proceeding to use https. This is fixed

in Patch 4.3.

CVE-2018-7295 has been assigned by [M](#) cve@mitre.org to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
