

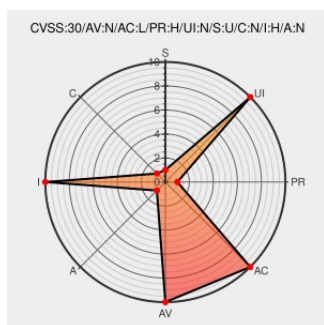

Certain versions of [Mybb](#) from [Mybb](#) contain the following vulnerability:

MyBB 1.8.14 is not checking for a valid CSRF token, leading to arbitrary deletion of user accounts.

CVE-2018-7305 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **MEDIUM** severity.
