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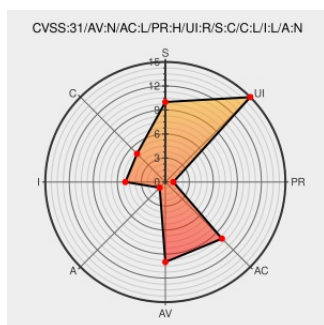

lyadmin 1.x has XSS via the config[WEB_SITE_TITLE] parameter to the /admin.php?s=/admin/config/groupsave.html URI.
