

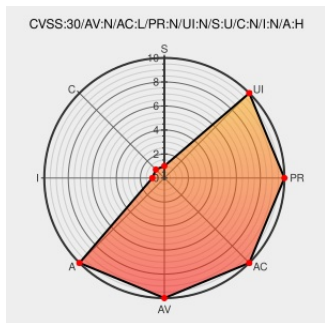

Certain versions of [Weblog Expert](#) from [Weblogexpert](#) contain the following vulnerability:

WebLog Expert Web Server Enterprise 9.4 allows Remote Denial Of Service (daemon crash) via a long HTTP Accept Header to TCP port 9991.

CVE-2018-7582 has been assigned by [M](#) [cve@mitre.org](#) to track the vulnerability - currently rated as **HIGH** severity.
